

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR A MORATORIUM ON THE APPROVAL OF
DATA CENTER PROJECTS

Notice is hereby given that on Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 6:00 P.M in the City Council Chambers, located at 500 Central Avenue, Connersville, IN The Fayette County Indiana Area Plan Commission, Indiana will hold a public hearing for a 12 month moratorium on the approval and development of data center projects for the purposes of ensuring public health, safety and general welfare.

Upon adoption of said moratorium by the, Board of Commissioners of Fayette County, Indiana, and the Common Council, of the City of Connersville, Indiana a twelve month moratorium on the approval and development of new data center projects, including AI data centers, to allow research into issues associated with public health, safety, and general welfare and the development of Area Zoning Code regulations regarding the development and approval of Data Centers.

Persons desiring to present their views, either written or verbal, may be heard at said time and place; written objections to the proposal that are filed with the Area Plan Commission office before the hearing will be considered; oral arguments concerning the proposal will be heard; and that the hearing may be continued from time to time.
